I have chosen the best lines of four of the greatest speeches in history that changed the world in their time. I shall show you how each can be translated to cover the problems we all face today. Then I shall outline a plan to take back our country within two years. It will require participation of all American citizens.

Let's begin with

Winston Churchill: We know of course he was speaking of fighting the Germans when he said, to wage war against a monstrous tyranny, never surpassed in the dark, lamentable catalogue of human crime." He could very easily have been speaking of fighting the deplorable tyranny to which our

federal government has sunk. A government hell bent on taking the most successful Republic Nation in the world, placing it in the hands of private corporations (from our currency to our defense and all points in between) with the intent of creating a single world government run by the largest International Corporation CEOs. This is indeed a more lamentable human crime than any legitimately declared war, because then we knew the enemy and fought to defeat them.

"Give Me Liberty or Give Me Death"

Patrick Henry

March 23, 1775

After Patrick Henry made this famous speech before the Virginia House of Burgesses at St. John's Church, his resolution to organize the militia of Virginia and to put the colony of Virginia on a war footing was unanimously adopted in that colony.

MR. PRESIDENT: It is natural to man to indulge in the illusions of hope. We are apt to shut our eyes against a painful truth -- and listen to the song of that siren, till she transforms us into beasts. Is this the part of wise men, engaged in a great and arduous struggle for liberty? Are we disposed to be of the number of those, who having eyes, see not, and having ears, hear not, the things which so nearly concern their temporal salvation? For my part, whatever anguish of spirit it may cost, I am willing to know the whole truth; to know the worst, and to provide for it.

I have but one lamp by which my feet are guided; and that is the lamp of experience. I know of no way of judging of the future but by the past. And judging by the past, I wish to know what there has been in the conduct of the British ministry for the last ten years, to justify those hopes with which gentlemen have been pleased to solace themselves and the house? Is it that insidious smile with which our petition has been lately received? Trust it not, sir; it will prove a snare to your feet. Suffer not yourselves to be betrayed with a kiss. Ask yourselves how this gracious reception of our petition comports with those warlike preparations which cover our waters and darken our land. Are fleets and armies necessary to a work of love and reconciliation? Have we shown ourselves so unwilling to be reconciled that force must be called in to win back our love? Let us not deceive ourselves, sir. These are the implements of war and subjugation -- the last arguments to which kings resort. I ask gentlemen, sir, what means this martial array, if its purpose be not to force us to submission? Can gentlemen assign any other possible motive for it? Has Great Britain any enemy in this quarter of the world, to call for all this accumulation of navies and armies? No, sir, she has none. They are meant for us: they can be meant for no other. They are sent over to bind and rivet upon us those chains which the British ministry have been so long forging. And what have we to oppose to them? Shall we try argument? Sir, we have been trying that for the

everyone in your congressional district to vote and share this message with them.

You have to carry the desire in your heart and the eternal fire in your guts to stand up to the pressure of making real change. It will become an obsession that directs your life forever after. It does get easier after a time until it just becomes a part of your normal routine. One thing I can promise you. Victory is sweet. When you can stand with your arm outstretched, palm upturned, close your fist and look down at it and marvel at how much power you now hold in your hand over your government you will never want to let it go again.

Our petitions have been slighted; our remonstrance’s have produced additional violence and insult; our supplications have been disregarded; and we have been spurned, with contempt, from the foot of the throne. In vain, after these things, may we indulge the fond hope of peace and reconciliation? There is no longer any room for hope. If we wish to be free -- if we mean to preserve inviolate those inestimable privileges for which we have been so long contending -- if we mean not basely to abandon the noble struggle in which we have been so long engaged, and which we have pledged ourselves never to abandon until the glorious object of our contest shall be obtained we must fight! -- repeat it, sir, we must fight! An appeal to arms and to the God of Hosts, is all that is left us!

They tell us, sir, that we are weak -- unable to cope with so formidable an adversary. But when shall we be stronger? Will it be the next week or the next year? Will it be when we are totally disarmed, and when a British guard shall be stationed in every house? Shall we gather strength by irresolution and inaction? Shall we acquire the means of effectual resistance by lying supinely on our backs, and hugging the delusive phantom of hope, until our enemies shall have bound us hand and foot? Sir, we are not weak, if we make a proper use of those means which the God of nature has placed in our power. Three millions of people, armed in the holy cause of liberty, and in such a country as that which we possess, are invincible by any force which our enemy can send against us. Besides, sir, we shall not fight our battles alone. There is a just God who presides over the destinies of nations; and who will raise up friends to fight our battles for us. The battle, sir, is not to the strong alone; it is to the vigilant, the

active, the brave. Besides, sir, we have no election. If we were base enough to desire it, it is now too late to retire from the contest. There is no retreat but in submission and slavery! Our chains are forged. Their clanking may be heard on the plains of Boston! The war is inevitable and let it come!! I repeat it, sir, let it come!!!

It is in vain, sir, to extenuate the matter. Gentlemen may cry, peace, peace -- but there is no peace. The war is actually begun! The next gale that sweeps from the north will bring to our ears the clash of resounding arms! Our brethren are already in the field! Why stand we here idle? What is it that gentlemen wish? What would they have? "Is life so dear, or peace so sweet, as to be purchased at the price of chains and slavery? Forbid it, Almighty God! -- I know not what course others may take; but as for me, give me liberty or give me death!"

Beautifully spoken words by one of my favorite Patriots. I have Liberty or Death tattooed on the left side of my head. Of course I have a Mohawk haircut so it is easily visible.

Again these words spoken over 200 years ago, bear semblance to our plight of today. There are those who have done their best to take away our arms, the fruit of our labors and the very document upon which this once great nation was founded. High taxes were one reason for the revolution against the Kings law. If all the taxes at every level had to be paid each time we made a purchase today, the average citizen would be stunned into taking immediate action against them. Take the time to read the Constitution, state or federal, and you will be amazed at the discrepancies between what it says can be done and what is actually taking place.

536 men and women are elected to represent the people at the federal level. Each has a particular role to play and those roles are designated by the Constitution. Congress is made up of two bodies, the House and the Senate. These two bodies make the laws which, in turn, can be signed or vetoed by the President. All monetary bills must originate in the House of Representatives. Though the President can put forth a proposed budget, only the Congress can pass a fiscal budget. The President then signs or vetoes the bill. Any bill vetoed by the President can have the veto overturned by a 2/3 majority vote of both Houses and it then becomes law. So you see there are checks and balances

- Conduct a Bipartisan Committee hearing on the feasibility for a Constitutional Amendment to limit the Supreme Court Justice's terms to 12 years. As Thomas Jefferson said:

“At the establishment of our constitutions, the judiciary bodies were supposed to be the most helpless and harmless members of the government. Experience, however, soon showed in what way they were to become the most dangerous; that the insufficiency of the means provided for their removal gave them a freehold and irresponsibility in office; that their decisions, seeming to concern individual suitors only, pass silent and unheeded by the public at large; that these decisions, nevertheless, become law by precedent, sapping, by little and little, the foundations of the constitution, and working its change by construction, before any one has perceived that that invisible and helpless worm has been busily employed in consuming its substance. In truth, man is not made to be trusted for life, if secured against all liability to account.”

Thomas Jefferson

- Return those duties specifically delegated to the Federal government but passed instead to private corporations, back into government control. Infrastructure (highways, bridges, Etc), Federal Reserve (print money and set interest rates) and any other such as may exist.

These are just a few of the really important changes that must be made rapidly. Transportation Commissioner Nancy Peters is praising the practice of handing over our infrastructure to foreign interests while at the same time the GAO (Government Accounting Office) is warning of the hidden cost that will bury the system in high hidden costs and dilapidated highway systems.

- Review all Agencies operating under the auspices of the federal government. Those that carry out activities not relegated to the federal government by the Constitution must be phased out and those duties be returned to the states where they rightfully belong.

candidate normally has to pay to get done. We recently had a State Rep that we put into office speak at one of our meetings. She told the crowd, I don't need you to give me any money. I would rather have you out knocking on doors for me one weekend than give me \$1000. You do a much better job than anyone I pay to do it. They are just doing it for money but you are doing it because you believe in me. It shows when you are talking." If of course you can't get there to work personally then donations with no strings attached are very welcome.

When an incumbent runs for reelection the media follows them around and reports on everything they do and say as news. If you have chosen to support a non-incumbent (we hope you have) write letters to the editor reporting on what they are doing and saying. Ask why they are not reporting on that candidate. If they receive enough letters they will decide maybe that is news and your candidate gets coverage. It resonates with the public and it is all free advertising.

And finally: Write a letter to the winner of the presidential election the day after they are sworn in and make them aware that you have read the Constitution and realize that most of what they promised during the campaign is unconstitutional. Let them know you will be watching to see if they keep their oath to uphold and defend the Constitution. To you the oath they take upon being sworn in is far more important than any campaign promises they made. If they stand true to that oath the other shit will take care of itself.

What do we expect to see happen as a result of this purging?

- Pass a Balanced Budget Bill during the first 100 days that does not allow any exceptions.

covering every bill throughout the process of becoming law. Unfortunately, passage for many of these bills are hidden from public view so you have no way of knowing how a particular Bill becomes law. The favored way is to have very little if any debate then have the Speaker say, 'without objection so ordered and another bill has become law with no recorded vote. They can also call for a voice vote and again there is no record of how your legislators vote. Even with a Roll Call vote the bills are written in such a way as to allow items not included in the bill to be added at a later date. Each bill gives the stated issue then adds, "**and for other purposes.**" These four words at the end of each bill allow Carte Blanche additions for items that are in no way germane to the original bill.

Presidential directives and executive orders are the way a President slips their desires past the public. They can simply issue the directive or order and, unless they are overturned by the Congress, they become law. This has become a simple way of turning our government functions over to the private sector with very little fanfare. By using this method individuals are put in charge of committees that should not even exist without a vote from anyone. They are all simply appointed to carry out duties in a fashion to suit themselves and those who put them into that position. Each such instance moves government a little farther from the scrutiny of those it is meant to serve.

That is where we find ourselves today. We have grown so accustomed to candidates lying while seeking election that we don't pay attention any more. We simply go in and vote for a name we recognize, generally the incumbent, without giving it a thought. Or, even worse, we vote for a candidate based simply on which Party we support. That is if we even bother to vote at all. We have become slaves to a group of men and women, many of whom should be in prison rather than in charge of our welfare.

Before I tell you what can be done to rectify this dilemma let me first tell you a little about my credentials. I dislike using the word I when speaking of the Texas Motorcycle Rights Association. None of our accomplishments would be possible if we had not all done our part. The success of this endeavor will also depend on each of us doing our part.

My name is Sputnik. Yes, only one word, in this world today that causes concern and my plane tickets have been marked more than once for special searches. I just quit flying. My driver's license is the only document that has me listed by my true name. I am a Biker and proud of it. In our world a man's word is his bond. You are loyal to family and friends, fiercely independent and willing to fight for our God-given rights and the Liberty to practice those rights. In my younger days I just wanted to be left alone. Like anyone else I voted and went home considering my job to be done for another two years. I didn't much care what laws were passed. If they were redundant laws I just figured do what you want to the other people but don't try to make me go by those laws and we will get along. Push me and I will push back harder.

I have no problem with peace officers or police officers. I have no use whatsoever for cops. In days of yore a peace officer's job was to keep the peace with the least amount of intrusion into your private life. Today that has changed. They are now called law enforcement officers and their main concern is to enforce laws that should never have been written and pad the coffers. Cops are people who belong behind bars, not behind a badge and a gun.

In 1992 I attended my first National Coalition of Motorcyclists Convention in New Jersey along with Bill Carlton. Thanks to US Senator Dave Durenberger, I realized that I had sold my grandkids into slavery to a totalitarian government by not being more involved in the political arena. After discussing the pros and cons with my wife I decided to see what I could do about the situation.

I founded the Texas Motorcycle Rights Association and began teaching other bikers how the political process really works and how to use it.

My first booklet was “Revolution The Real Solution.” It explained the different meanings given to revolution in the dictionary and then called for a political revolution. The second booklet, which has been spread across the country, was

Walk down the street three — four blocks in one direction knocking on each door on that side of the street. Cross the street and do the same thing going back the other direction. Then move on down and start again. Depending on which Party the candidate you are supporting is with you will be told to skip any that are evidently supporters of the other Party. I say Bull Shit, especially during this Revolution.

Knock on the door and strike up a conversation with the occupant. Direct a brief discussion about issues that concern them in the upcoming election. Sell yourself to them as a citizen who basically has the same concerns once you hit on points of agreement. Explain to them how you believe the problems can be corrected. Mention the movement and the goal to return a Free America to our children and our grand children.

Then and only then do you mention the candidate you are supporting who has the same beliefs and is pledged to serve their term in office to bring about the citizen's demands for a revitalization of America. Thank them for their time and leave some literature. This has taken about 10-12 minutes and you have made a lasting impression.

The number of Independent voters is growing by huge numbers as things deteriorate. We have a state group called Indy Texans with a web site at <http://indytexans.org>. This is not an Independent Party, rather they work with candidates regardless of Party based on their qualifications. There is also a national headquarters. One of the Board Members for Indy Texans also sits on the National Board of Independent voters. Her name is Linda Curtis and it has been a real pleasure working with her this past year. That just may be the best solution for the 2010 election.

It is not necessary to give a cash donation to a candidate. We stated when we began this association that TMRA 2 would not support any candidate financially. That is why we oppose PACs. We go out and do the work that a

have no problem speaking with strangers. As a phone solicitor you won't have as much time to interact with other workers but your services won't go unnoticed.

With the advent of cell phones it is possible to work from your own home at your own pace calling people you know and asking them to get together for coffee at the local coffee shop. Meet with several at a time and form working groups in your Congressional District.

Putting up yard signs is the tried and true method of involvement in a campaign. Again you can do as much or as little as you choose. You will need a crew and a pickup for this job and it is normally done on weekends. If you choose to do the standard job, you will pick up assembled signs at a predesignated location. You will be given a list of specific areas to cover and a list of addresses where the occupants have agreed to allow signs to be erected. It doesn't hurt if you can provide extra locations for this project. You will generally spend most of the day Saturday and possibly Sunday afternoons on this assignment. You will travel to each location and speak with the occupant if possible. Identify yourself and verify their willingness to allow the signs to be posted. Place the sign(s) in the location of their choice and move on to the next location.

If you have the time and manpower and really want to get involved you can run the entire sign campaign. If this much involvement is possible it will really be beneficial to you in the future. Signs will be picked up unassembled and you will not only distribute them but assemble them as well. If your interest runs in this direction we will be more than happy to train you and your crew as to the best methods possible to conduct this very important undertaking. As you move on to Step 5 you will see why this is so important. This is the ultimate in volunteer duty. By accepting this much responsibility you show yourself as willing to go the extra mile. You also are freeing up other workers and cash to be used by the candidate elsewhere.

Finally, knock on doors:

“Five Steps To Freedom” (one step at a time). It began with register to vote, get acquainted and work campaigns, vote in the Primary, become a State Delegate to your Party and finally run for office. At that time I asked the Texas Riders to do just one thing, become State Delegates to the Party of their choice during the next Primary election. I explained that they need not be concerned about the big picture that I had that figured out. If they would do just that one thing and we were successful in taking back our state it would be thanks to them. If we weren't successful it would be my fault because I hadn't looked at the big picture properly. I was offering a win-win situation. They did that one thing and it worked beyond even my expectations. We rode into our first Democratic State Convention a rag tag army and rode out as seasoned veterans of the political arena.

I complained about why we weren't taught politics in school. When it became time to print a new government text book for college I received a call to do an interview. When the new text book came out we had 7 pages in it. Besides doing seminars for biker groups I began getting calls to address college classes. It gives one real satisfaction to see a student's eyes light up when they realize they are hearing something they haven't been told prior to your visit. It is doubly satisfying to meet students at the capitol after you have spoken to their class and have them acknowledge their thanks by asking for an autograph. We now have a TV Show in Austin called “Texas Politics Biker Style.” Our shows can be viewed on the internet at our website by the same name. I am recognized most anywhere I go by someone. The next booklet was “Run for Office and Win” (with very little money). This booklet explained that name recognition was the best way to win an election. If you have a large dedicated staff of volunteers to make your name become a household word then you will win regardless of how much money your opponent spends. Again this training aid became a success and we began putting bikers into office. That gives you some idea how I have spent the last 18 years. I thank God for the Texas Riders who had faith in my plan and worked to make it become a success. We have put Bikers and non-bikers alike in office at all levels of government using these booklets as our guidelines.

I pray that God will give all citizens that same faith and willingness to win this time around. Our country's future depends on it. . So enough about me; let's get ready to play the game, the right way.

For the past sixteen years I have followed closely the workings of our government from the city level right on up to the Federal level. I have done this as Founder and State Chair of the Texas Motorcycle Rights Association. I began by reading the US and Texas State Constitutions over and over again. It was easy to see where no level of government was following the constitutions but the only way I could find written therein to make change was revolution. I therefore wrote a booklet called 'Revolution the Real Solution.' Of course armed revolution was a lose-lose situation and not to even be considered except as a final recourse. I explained to our members we have a small window of time when we can make change by means of a political revolution but we must all get involved.

I read each bill introduced in Texas and realized that the legislators were aware the bills did not meet constitutional muster. I sat in the Gallery and watched them make a mockery of the Texas Constitution on a daily basis by voting to suspend the constitutional rules and vote on a bill. It became very clear to me that they did this knowing that no one was paying any attention to what they did during the session. During this time I purchased a satellite dish so I could watch the Feds in session on C-Span and C-Span 2. I became even more incensed.

I then wrote a booklet 'Five Steps to Freedom' (one step at a time). I had determined that the Party in the majority ran the government. If we were to make changes in our Texas legislature we had to get involved in the Parties as delegates, committee members and state officers. We had to work campaigns to elect people we could trust. Finally we had to elect our members to office at all levels of government in our state. We were successful at each step and we continue to be even more successful with each election.

About this time I was approached and told that this plan couldn't work just at the state level. There were people in government who believed as I did and would be more than happy to work with me to go national with my message.

purging is accomplished will ring out for years to come. Then it will just require maintenance.

Your prior contact with the candidates has given you a choice as to whom you will support in the election and why, Personal involvement in a campaign is better and receives more notice, from a candidate or their staff, than a cash donation. Others may disagree and I won't argue with their views. We began on the assumption, a citizen becoming educated in the process and getting personally involved can make a difference. This theory has been proven to be correct. Flyers are picked up at the campaign headquarters at a designated time and passed out on the street, in shopping malls or anywhere not prohibited by law. You may volunteer as often or as sparingly as you wish. Once or twice a week about 2 hours per day is generally sufficient.

Stuffing envelopes is the best way to become familiar with other campaign workers, the candidate and their staff. You will meet with other workers to collate, fold and put campaign material into envelopes to be mailed later. This task gets your candidates message out and allows you time to interact with others who could be helpful to your cause in the legislative session. This is the perfect job for someone not adept at going out and talking to strangers but can be group friendly.

The next form of service in a campaign is working phone banks. For this task you will show up at a designated time and location which will have several phones installed. You will be given a list of names to call and to convince the person with whom you speak to not only vote but to vote for your candidate. 2-3 hours per evening, twice a week is considered sufficient but if you can give more time, do so. For this assignment you must have a strong clear voice and

After our first session I gave a copy of Five Steps To Freedom to every legislator in the state capitol. I told them we didn't come down here to just pass a bill or kill a bill. We came down here to take back our government. Several of our Warriors said, "You shouldn't have done that". I told them, "I'm kind'a like Billy Jack. It's more fun to tell them what you are going to do and then do it." We did.

Get Acquainted, with those in your congressional district in the area. Pay close attention to how your Congressman votes during the upcoming session. Be especially watchful of the bills they author, co-author or sponsor. Be mindful of whether those bills and other bills they vote yes for are within the purview of the powers granted to them, as federal legislators, under the Constitution. Share this information with everyone with whom you come in contact throughout the year. Write a letter to the editor of your local newspaper when that Congressman does something wrong. Be just as quick to compliment them by the same means when they do something right. It may surprise you to know they read those newspapers from home.

I recommend that you give a copy of this booklet to your Congressman. Let them know what you are looking for in your next Federal Legislator and if they can't walk the walk they can walk on down the road next election. Give them every opportunity to be the best that they can be once your expectations have been laid on the table. If they can meet the challenge that is fine, support them for re-election. If they veer off just a little bit for the sake of expedience it is positively time for change.

Work a Campaign, choose your next candidate wisely.

The purpose of this entire plan is to remove those Congressmen from office who have forgotten what their duties are to the country and to the individuals they have been elected to serve. I know that most voters consider themselves to be Republican or Democrat. After all these years of following politics intently, it has currently become my life, there is basically no difference in the two Parties. By that I mean their main concern is re-election and power. I strongly recommend that you search for a qualified candidate in the other Parties this time around also. Remember this is a one time deal. The message sent once this

These people would give me inside information and would pay the cost of putting the word out on a national level. Their positions would not allow them to speak out but I could be the spokesman. It has been my experience that when you are offered this type help you pay a price. I respectfully declined and became a national political speaker on my own based on the reputation of TMRA 2. With support mostly from NCOM, the Aim Attorneys and the member groups I have done Workshops and Seminars in 44 states across the country.

Besides using C-Span and C-Span 2 I began using the url www.thomas.loc.gov to read the federal bills, and find who authored them as well as the co-sponsors. I read the amendments offered and by whom and how they were voted on. I then could read the final action on the bill.

Sounds good doesn't it? What you probably aren't aware of is that most bills don't even receive a hearing and pass without a vote. It is a matter of record that about 90% of the Senate bills were passed in that fashion this session. Is that what you call a government of the people, by the people and for the people?

I signed up for Congress.org to get Email reports on the federal government actions. Everywhere that you can imagine to stay up with what happens on the state and federal level I have set up on my computer.

I was fortunate enough to get involved with a group of like minded folks and am a Charter Member of Biker Republic. This is strictly an informational group and between them not much happens that they aren't aware of. They can make computers walk and talk and what one may miss the other one posts to the list. We also have put up a list called infobikerrepublic.org where anyone can sign

up to post information on any subject. There is a list for forurn@bikerrepublic.org where you can go and discuss anything you read on the info list. To sign up for either of the two lists just go to <http://bikerrepublic.org/maillinglists.html> and sign up. No personal attacks and no discussion on the info list. These lists generate a lot of information but it will really come in handy if you are going to do your part in what needs to be done. This will be the most important thing you ever do in your life and I'm sure you all believe you have done some important things in your lifetime.

Remember I told you we began our movement in Texas with "Revolution The Real Solution"? With all the happenings during the past year I realized that our window of time had closed for making change politically. I became very distraught as I watched the light go out when the window slammed shut. Of course there have been ups and downs in this sixteen year war but we have always continued to move forward. Finally I sensed a glimmer of light coming through a crack at the bottom of the door where career politicians had left themselves a way out and I knew we had one more chance.

During the past six years my health has deteriorated drastically. I use a nebulizer machine each four hours, six different inhalers at set times of each day, a C-Pap machine at night and have been put on oxygen 24/7. My time is also running out. I chose to check first with the Warriors of the Texas Motorcycle Rights Association for guidance. I explained the basics of what I intended to do and asked only one question of them. Do I do this as State Chairman of Texas Motorcycle Rights Association or do I leave the association out of it and simply do it on my own. The overwhelming response from those Warriors was "you are the chairman and we are behind you." Tears came into my eyes as I read those messages and they are now as I write this little part (break time)

Members of this association have never let me down which is the reason for our success. Without the faith and support of my Brothers and Sisters I would still just be a dumb assed biker from the wrong side of the track, quite possibly in prison or dead by now. I thank God for these Warriors. Instead we are one of the most respected and successful organizations in our state capitol today. So

To qualify to be a player in this game you must first be a man of honesty, honor and integrity.

Your word is your bond and a handshake is a contract that requires no written words.

You must have faith and trust.

You must have the faith and trust possessed by those Warriors in Texas who accepted on faith that I had a plan that would work and trusted me to have the big picture laid out correctly to insure victory.

You must have commitment.

You must be committed to protect our Constitution from enemies, both domestic and foreign. Committed to spending the next year to not only finding the information you will need to make the correct decision in your area but to share that information by word of mouth, by letters to the editor and contact with your federal congressman by letter, phone and personal meetings.

It is time now to take some of those Five Steps:

Register To Vote, and get everyone you know registered to vote. This entire plan is based on being a registered voter. Even if you believe yourself to be registered, double check. Look at your voter registration card or call your county court house to be certain. With all the attempts at purging the voter roles it is just possible your name was removed. Don't just register to vote, get out and do it.

During a non-presidential election the number of actual voters will be less than during a presidential election year. Records in Texas show it averages between 48- 55%. That means our Revolution receives a 50% boost just by staging during the next election cycle. The timing will never be better and we can't afford to fail.

All we face is the loss of a little time. In some countries those who attempt to vote face the possibility of harassment or even death if they try to vote. Still their voting record is nearly twice as high as is the percentage of those voting in this country.

Andrew Jackson was elected to Congress. When he was running for re-election he went back to the man who set up a meeting and fundraiser for him when he first ran. He told the man, ‘Remember when I ran for office you supported me and did a fundraiser for me? Well I’m running again and would like your help.’ The man told him, “Yes! remember but you lied to me and I won’t be voting for you this time” When Jackson asked what he meant he told him, “Remember when that town’s (it slips my mind which one at the moment) city hail burned down and you voted to give them money to rebuild it? That was my money. If I wanted to give them money that was up to me but it wasn’t up to you to give them my money.” Andrew Jackson lost that election and moved to Texas. Where are the men like that today? Is it OK for legislators to spread your money all over the world, including to our enemies? Do you still vote for them because they are in your Party? Despite the shame of it you do, which makes you a willing accomplice to the corruption. Hopefully you will see fit to join the Revolution and abandon the Party.

Forget about your State Senator:

Each State only has two US Senators and they are voted on by the entire state. They each get six year terms so you can vote on one of them this time and the next time one of them comes up for a vote you can vote for them. This is a very important duty but again I say they get six year terms so that doesn’t fit into our time frame. For the last few years, each time something goes wrong that draws the ire of a few citizens each Party points the finger at the other Party to place the blame. I recently read an Email that said in part:

“If the Democrats want a balanced budget and the Republicans want a balanced budget, why don’t we have a balanced budget? If the Democrats want independence from foreign oil and the Republicans want independence from foreign oil, why don’t we have independence from foreign oil?”
You get the picture. They each claim to want all the things we don’t have but put the blame on the other Party.

How did we get here?

We went off the gold standard and made our money worthless. Then we began privatizing the federal government in direct opposition to the Constitution.
